



General Rules

- Hours of operation are 9 am to 9 pm daily, the lifeguard schedules may vary
- Members are expected to volunteer their time and talents to support the operation of the club
- Members are responsible to clean up after themselves, their children and their guests (including but not limited to popsicle wrappers)
- The last member to leave the club each evening should make sure all umbrellas are closed, toys are put away, the radio and lights are turned off and all doors, windows and gates are locked

Supervision of Children

- The lifeguards are not a substitute for childcare, parents must be attentive to their children at all times
- Children who require a floatation device while swimming must be under the direct supervision of a parent, guardian or caregiver
- Children under 13 must be supervised by a parent, guardian or caregiver who is at least 15 years old when a lifeguard is on duty
- When no lifeguard is on duty, children under 18 must be supervised by a parent, guardian or caregiver who is at least 18 years old
- The Board reserves the right to revoke the privilege of unsupervised teenagers at the club as deemed necessary

Health and Safety

- No member or guest shall swim in or use the lake alone, someone must be available to call for help
- Children who are not toilet trained MUST wear a swim diaper
- No food or beverage of any kind is allowed in the pool
- No glass containers are allowed near the pool or pool deck
- No person with a communicable disease or a contagious illness is allowed in the pool
- No running or diving
- No water guns, inflatable rafts or rings are allowed in the pool or pool enclosure
- No weapons of any kind should be brought onto BSC property

Weather

- In the event of a thunderstorm, all persons must leave the outside enclosure area and seek shelter
- During a thunderstorm everyone must exit the pool and remain out of the pool for at least 20 minutes after the last thunder was heard

Guest Policy

- Members are responsible for their guests at all times
- All guests MUST be accompanied by a member and signed in
- Guest fees are billed on a monthly basis
- The same guest (non-member) is limited to two visits per season, this does not apply to overnight, out of town visitors or designated caregivers

Party or Gatherings Hosted at the Pool Club

- All parties or large gatherings are defined as a gathering of seven (7) or more non-members
- All parties must be pre-approved by the Lifeguard committee

Gas Grills and Charcoal Grills

- The clubhouse has grilling utensils available and they must be cleaned after use
- The club provides charcoal and charcoal lighter fluid at the beginning of the season
- The club had two propane tanks for the gas grill and strives to keep a back-up tank filled as a courtesy

Lake and Outside the Pool Enclosure

- Secret Lake Association Beach is a private beach and not a BSC membership privilege
- Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or caregiver at least 15 years old
- The lifeguard is not responsible for any activity on the lake or outside the pool enclosure

Boat Storage

- Members may store their nonmotor boat at the club during the summer season for a fee (see current year membership form for information on cost)
- No parking is allowed at the shoreline that blocks access to members launching boats
- All nonmotor boats must visibly display their assigned Briarcliff Swim Club sticker.
- The Board reserves the right to remove any vessel not properly tagged.

Canoes and Kayaks

- All members (regardless of age) who use watercraft on the lake are REQUIRED to wear life jackets
- All members have access to canoes owned by the club during the season
- No canoes or boats should be left on the shoreline
